

Community GROUPS



NOT JUST A BIBLE STUDY

Community Groups meet weekly in homes as well as on the TLR campus to share in friendship, discipleship, and serving. Each group typically runs 1.5 to 2 hours per session.

Community Groups run for 10 weeks. Your group will participate in group discussion, following the guide of the study material. You will experience encouragement and prayer from the support of your group members. Light snacks are also typically served.

Apart from just coming together for your group sessions, Community Groups plan and prepare community service projects. Typical projects include feeding the homeless, helping someone move, take needed meals, and yard care, just to name a few.

Your group will also share in three experiences together outside of your group time: prayer, serving, and fun activities.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

This cost is for all the children in your family. Whether you have 1 child or 6, the price is the same.



The Genesis Process provides a Biblical and neurochemical understanding of what is broken and causes our coping skills.

If we don't first understand what is broken, how can we devise a recovery plan that really works? We believe the best evangelism is a changed life. Therefore it is the goal of The Genesis Process and Programs to be intimately involved as part of the body of Christ in the Great Commission through the successful restoration of broken lives

The Bible and other literature have told us for literally thousands of years that if we want to change who we are and what we do, we have to change our heart. New understanding from brain research shows us how trauma (abuse and neglect) can distort who we are and what we believe and thus how we act. Genesis is intentional about initiating lasting heart (brain) changes, thus bringing healing to what drives destructive behavior rather than just coping with it.

The Genesis Process includes 20 sessions to work through. The cost is \$40 for the group which includes the workbook and the celebration dinner.



It may be hard for you to feel optimistic about the future right now. If you've lost a spouse, child, family member, or friend, you've probably found there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel. This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have many questions about things you've never faced before.

GriefShare groups meet weekly for **13 weeks** to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. You will experience video seminars featuring top experts on grief and recovery. After viewing the video, you and the other group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in your lives. During the week you will have the opportunity to use your workbook for further personal study of the grieving process, and to help sort out your emotions through journaling.

Cost for GriefShare is \$25 for the workbook.
